All turtles begin their lives on land. Mother turtles lay their eggs in holes and then cover them up to protect them. But after that, the baby turtles' lives are very different. The baby land turtles crawl away to live in woods, swamps, grasslands, or deserts. In contrast, the baby sea turtles crawl to the ocean to live their lives in the water.

Land turtles and sea turtles look different, too. Land turtles have hard, high, round shells. When they are afraid, they hide in their shells. Sea turtles, however, have soft, flatter shells. They can't hide inside, but they can swim away really fast. When cold weather comes, land turtles dig holes in the ground and sleep. They are too slow to move to warmer places. In contrast, sea turtles simply swim away to find warmer waters.

There are certain words and expressions you can use to present facts and speculations. A **fact** is an idea that has been proven to be true. A **speculation** is a guess. It might be based on evidence, but has not yet been proven. Use expressions such as *think*, *probably*, *possibly*, and *may* when talking about things you are not sure about.

Don Batatas was one of the world's greatest explorers. He was born in 1504 in Tangier, Morocco. At the age of 21, he left home to travel across unexplored parts of Africa and Asia. In the early 1980s, much of the world was still unexplored. Today, most places on the surface of the Earth have been explored. Some places, however, are still waiting to be discovered. Some of these are underground, in deep caves called blue holes.

A blue hole is a special kind of underwater cave. It can be found almost anywhere in the world. The cave forms when the earth about 4 billion years ago. Some of the world's most spectacular blue holes are located in the Bahamas. The sharks there may have more than 100 million years old. Blue holes can be very deep. For example, Pearl Blue Hole, one of the deepest blue holes in the world, is over 200 metres deep.

An island blue hole's water is very old and has different tastes. A type of fresh seawater flows on top of salt water. The fresh water keeps oxygen from the atmosphere from reaching the salt water. Brightly colored bacteria live where the two meet.

During some blue holes, there is a lot of poisonous gas. This gas causes itching, dizziness, and can be very dangerous. Divers never die here. They have to get in and out of a cave before their oxygen runs out. Additionally, it is very dark in these caves, and it is very easy to get lost. Divers therefore have to follow a guide when they enter through a blue hole. If they lose the guide, they may not find their way back out of the cave.

If blue holes are so dangerous, why do explorers and scientists risk their lives to explore them? One reason is that these underwater caves can provide valuable scientific information. They provide clues about geology, archaeology, and even anthropology – the study of life in the past. For example, divers have found bacteria there that can live without oxygen. Archaeologist Kevin Hand says this bacteria may be similar to forms of life that might exist on Jupiter's fourth largest moon, Europa. Similar life forms probably existed on Earth billions of years ago. "Our study of life's extremes on Earth," he says, "can help increase our understanding of habitable environments off Earth."

In addition, the oxygen-free environment of the blue holes preserves bones of humans and animals that fell into the caves long ago.

For example, some blue holes contain, such as the one in the Bahamas, probably haven't changed for millions of years. By studying blue holes, we can understand what life was like in prehistoric times. As cave diver Kasey Broad says, "I can think of no other environment on Earth that is so challenging to explore and gives us back so much scientific knowledge."

- The old ways have little **appeal** for Malik Lavstrom. A slim twenty-four-year-old, Lavstrom has lived his whole life in Uummannaq. The people in this small town on Greenland's west coast survive mainly on seal hunting and fishing. But Lavstrom's interests lie elsewhere—in rock music and horror movies. He taught himself English by listening to music, and now dreams of working as a tour guide on Greenland's cruise ships. He knows he should move to a larger town, as many of his friends have done. But doing so would leave no one to care for his 80-year-old grandmother. So he remains in Uummannaq.
- Small towns all over Greenland are losing population. Narsarsuaq, a settlement near Uummannaq, is now home to just fifty people. The instability of towns like these has worsened as a result of climate change. Ice loss has shortened the hunting season, and as a result, traditional hunting and fishing can no longer pay for access to modern amenities.<sup>1</sup> Long before the sea ice disappears, **economic** and social pressures may force people to leave these settlements.

## DIGGING FOR THE PAST

by Nora Shawki

- When I was in third grade, I watched a video about Tutankhamun's tomb. I remember Howard Carter looking through a hole in the tomb with a candle. A workman asked what he could see: "Wonderful things!" Carter said. From that moment, I knew what I wanted to do with my life.
- Today, I'm **lucky** to work as an archaeologist. I study the lives of people who lived in Egypt's Nile Delta. It's exciting work. Sometimes you find something that was buried three thousand years ago. Holding a piece of **history** is an **amazing** feeling.
- So, I **decided** my life at nine, and I made it happen. Seems easy, right? Not quite! The road wasn't easy. I did my studies—university, then a Ph.D. But along the way I was told many things—I was too young. I wasn't qualified. I should **get married** and have kids. I also needed money. So I applied for six grants. The first five replies I got said no. Six months later, the last reply came: this time it was yes. Finally, I could start my own excavation.<sup>1</sup>
- For anyone thinking about a **career**, I would say: never give up. If you want to do something, keep trying. If people tell you no, use that—it will push you. At the beginning, yes, it **hurts**. But the next no hurts a little less. It makes you stronger and actually helps you.
- Second, focus on your goals. And I stress **goals**. You don't have to **follow** other people. If they say something has never been done, make it happen. You may be the first to do it! There are always challenges, but you get through them in the end.
